Business, Community Welfare and Computer Studies Students

Orientation is conducted on the morning of the first day of the commencement of your course. During Orientation you will be introduced to the College, to support staff, course requirements and to living in Melbourne or Adelaide.

Your Head of Study will conduct Orientation. You will be given a copy of the Student Handbook.

English Language Studies Students

You will also take an English level test and have an interview.
