Description of the Qualification

This course is ideal for people wishing to gain a broad and thorough knowledge of the Printing and Graphic Arts Industry while the Diploma of Multimedia provides trainees with the skills and knowledge to work in many areas of multimedia design and production across the arts, entertainment, e-commerce and media industries. Trainees have the opportunity to develop the multimedia skills in digital graphics, web page development, 2D and 3D animation, screen design, multimedia authoring, programming and knowledge of scripting languages and advanced HTML as well as pre-press skills in typography, design and layout, preparing files for print, scanning images, image outputting, scheduling basics, customer service, and a range of software applications used in the pre-press industry today. On successful completion, a trainee has developed the skills necessary to work as a member of a multimedia development team or perform the duties of a pre-press tradesperson.

Work Experience

CIC guarantees the trainee 900 hours of work experience in the Graphic Pre-Press field; of which 540 hours are paid.

Duration

The Certificate III in Printing and Graphic Arts (Graphic Pre-press) and Diploma of Multimedia are delivered over two years of full-time study. On satisfactory completion of the first year of study, a trainee is eligible to receive the Certificate III in Printing and Graphic Arts (Graphic Pre-press).
